12	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the

17	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
18	Sec. 1. STATEWIDE SCHOOL DISTRICT; PROPOSAL; REPORT
19	(a) In order to maximize the ability to provide equitable educational
20	opportunities to the State's small, declining student population while also

1	minimizing administrative and overhead costs, the Secretary of Education shall
2	develop a proposal by which the State shall transition to a single statewide
3	school district. In developing the proposal, the Secretary shall consider the
4	education governance model in Hawaii, including the positive and negative
5	effects that transition to the model has had on educational opportunities,
6	outcomes, and budgets in Hawaii and on the provision and funding of special
7	education services in that state. The Secretary shall also investigate the need
8	for waivers or other federal actions necessary to transition Vermont to a
9	statewide school district.
10	(b) On or before January 15, 2018, the Secretary shall present a detailed
11	proposal, including a timeline, to the House and Senate Committees on
12	Education to transition the State to a single statewide school district by fiscal
13	<u>year 2022.</u>
