| 16 | the U.S. Armed Forces, disability as defined by 21 V.S.A. § 495d(5), sexual |
| 17 | orientation, or gender identity shall be subject to the following penalties: |
| 18 | (1) If the maximum penalty for the underlying crime is one year or less, |
| 19 | the penalty for a violation of this section shall be imprisonment for not more |
| 20 | than two years or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both. |

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| 2 | year but less than five years, the penalty for a violation of this section shall be |
