

H.509 (Vetoed). Taxation and fees

This bill would have:

- set the property dollar yield for fiscal year 2018 at \$10,160.00, the income dollar yield for fiscal year 2018 at \$11,990.00, and the nonresidential property tax rate at \$1.555 (Secs. 1–2)
- increased percentage of sales and use tax revenue allocated to the Education Fund by one percent, effective for fiscal year 2019 (Secs. 3–4)
- created a commission to study and report on moving to a negotiated statewide health care benefit for school employees in the future (Sec. 5)
- required that collective bargaining contracts with healthcare benefits for teachers shall expire on or before September 1, 2019
