7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish a
8	carbon pollution fee that starts at \$10.00 per ton and increases each year until it
9	equals the "Social Cost of Carbon" as set forth in the U.S. Environmental
10	Protection Agency's "Technical Support Document: - Technical Update of the
11	Social Cost of Carbon for Regulatory Impact Analysis - Under Executive
12	Order 12866" (dated August 2016). The bill proposes that Vermont consumers
13	and businesses pay a fee when purchasing fossil fuels and that the Department
14	of Taxes calculate the percentage shares of revenue collected from individuals
15	and from businesses. The bill then proposes that the revenue collected from
16	individuals be returned to individuals on an equal and quarterly basis in the
17	form of dividend checks or direct deposits, and the revenue collected from
18	businesses be returned to businesses in the same manner.
