9	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to eliminate
10	Vermont's sales and use tax by reducing the tax by one percent each year, for
11	six years. At the same time, a fee would be imposed on corporations
12	distributing fossil fuels that emit carbon dioxide pollution. The fee would be
13	increased over a six-year period to replace the revenue forgone from the
14	elimination of the sales and use tax, in a revenue-neutral manner. Nonprofits
15	and municipalities would be exempt from the carbon fee.
