mandated recyclables; collection containers

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the  
owner or operator of a gas station to provide collection containers for  
mandated recyclables at or near the fuel pump.

An act relating to recycling containers at gas stations

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 6605n is added to read:

§ 6605n. RECYCLING CONTAINERS; GASOLINE STATIONS

(a) As used in this section:

(1) “Diesel fuel” shall have the same meaning as “fuel” set forth in

23 V.S.A. § 3002.

(2) “Gas station” means a fixed physical location where a person sells

motor fuel or diesel fuel directly to consumers.

1           (3) “Motor fuel” shall have the same meaning as set forth in 23 V.S.A.

2           § 3101.

3           (b) The owner or operator of a gas station shall provide collection  
4           containers for mandated recyclables at or near the fuel pump.

5           Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

6           This act shall take effect on January 1, 2019.
