16	This subchapter shall apply to all licenses, registrations, and applications for
17	licenses and registrations which that the Commissioner or the Department may
18	issue or grant, unless otherwise specifically provided.

1	(8) The Department shall consider all variances to its rules pertaining to
2	the educational requirements of a provider operating or employed at a
3	registered or licensed family child care home or a center-based child care and
4	preschool program.
5	Sec. 2. OUTREACH; CHILD CARE PROVIDERS
6	On or before September 1, 2018, the Department for Children and Families
7	shall post on its website guidance manuals to supplement the Department's
8	rules on registered and licensed family child care homes and center-based child
9	care and preschool programs. The Department shall also publish on its website
10	on a quarterly basis a newsletter pertaining to compliance with child care
11	providers' educational requirements.
