- 15 <u>members</u> whose term of office shall be for four years and until a successor is
- 16 appointed. Two members of the Board shall be lay persons not admitted to
- 17 practice law in this or any other <u>State state</u>. The Supreme Court shall annually
- 18 appoint not more than three <u>four</u> members of the Board on October 1.
- 19 Vacancies in the Board may be filled by the Court. The Commissioner of
