16	mineral waters, mixed wine drink, soda water, and carbonated soft drinks in
17	liquid form and intended for human consumption. As of January 1, 1990
18	"beverage" also shall mean liquor.

1	(3) "Container" means the individual, separate, bottle, can, jar, or carton
2	composed of glass, metal, paper, plastic, or any combination of those materials
3	containing a consumer product. This definition shall not include containers
4	made of biodegradable material.

6	(11) "Hard cider" means a beverage produced by fermentation of the
7	juice of fruit, including flavored, sparkling, or carbonated cider, that contains
8	not less than one-half of one percent alcohol by volume and not more than
9	eight and one-half percent alcohol by volume.

11	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
