14	Terms used in this subchapter have the following meanings, unless a
15	different meaning is clearly apparent from the language or context:
16	(1) "Commissioner," means the Commissioner of Labor or designee;.
17	(2) "Employee;" means any individual employed or permitted to work
18	by an employer except:

1	(I) secondary-school students working during all or any part of the
2	school year of, regular vacation periods, or periods between successive
3	academic years or terms.
4	(3) "Occupation;" means an industry, trade, or business or branch
5	thereof, or a class of work in which workers are gainfully employed.
6	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
7	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
