6	Subject: Conservation and development; water resources; water quality; lake
7	in crisis
8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to authorize the
9	Agency of Natural Resources (ANR) to declare a lake to be in crisis if the
10	condition of the water poses a potential harm to the public health, poses a risk
11	of damage to the environment or natural resources, or is likely to cause
12	significant devaluation of property value or other significant negative
13	economic effects. When a lake is declared to be in crisis, ANR shall be
14	designated the State agency with sole authority for regulation of water quality
15	requirements in the watershed of the lake in crisis, provided that all other State
16	agencies shall provide ANR with necessary technical and administrative
17	services for the required responses. When a lake is declared to be in crisis, the
18	State shall appropriate financial resources to ANR sufficient to improve the
19	quality of the lake in crisis.

ANR is authorized to issue emergency orders requiring activities
contributing to the conditions of the lake in crisis to cease, including, if the
source of pollution in the lake is phosphorus, cessation in the watershed of
agricultural practices that contribute phosphorus to the lake. If an ANR
emergency order requires cessation of agricultural practices in the watershed of
the lake in crisis, ANR shall compensate farmers in the watershed for
economic losses directly attributable to the emergency order. ANR shall
review all agricultural practices in the watershed, including application of
nutrients according to a nutrient management plan. ANR shall hold at least
one public hearing and accept notice and comment for any water quality
program or project implemented in the watershed of a lake in crisis. All
records produced or acquired by ANR in establishing a water quality program
or project in the watershed shall be subject to public inspection and copying
under the Public Records Act, including nutrient management plans of farms in
the watershed.
The bill would declare Lake Carmi to be a lake in crisis. ANR would be
required to establish an emergency response plan for Lake Carmi on or before
April 1, 2018. The emergency response plan for Lake Carmi shall include
funding necessary for implementation of a phosphorus management plan that
incorporates requirements for aeration of the lake.
