Subject: Elections; definition of “candidate”; constitutional qualifications for
office; registered voter

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend the
definition of “candidate” in election law to clarify that it means an individual
constitutionally qualified to hold an office, which includes the requirement that
the individual be a registered voter in accordance with Vt. Const. Ch. I, Art. 8.

An act relating to the constitutional qualifications to be a “candidate”

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 17 V.S.A. § 2103 is amended to read:

§ 2103. DEFINITIONS

As used in this title, unless the context or a specific definition requires a
different reading:

* * *

(7) “Candidate” means an individual who is constitutionally qualified to
hold a public office, which, pursuant to Vt. Const. Ch. I, Art. 8, includes the
requirement that the individual be a registered voter, and who has taken any

1 affirmative action to become a candidate for public office. A person takes
2 affirmative action by:

3 (A) accepting a contribution or making an expenditure directly or
4 indirectly;

5 (B) filing the requisite petition for one of the named positions or
6 being nominated by primary or otherwise; or

7 (C) publicly announcing that he or she seeks such a position.
