| 11 | (a) 9 V.S.A. chapter 138 (campgrounds) is redesignated as 9 V.S.A. |
| 12 | chapter 142. |
| 13 | (b) 9 V.S.A. § 4470 (campgrounds; removal) is redesignated as 9 V.S.A. |

| 15 | Sec. 2. 9 V.S.A. § 4470 is added to read: |
| 16 | § 4470. INSTALLATION OF ANTENNAS |
| 17 | (a) Definitions. As used in this section: |
| 18 | (1) "Antenna" means a device, and any mast used to support the device, |
| 19 | that is designed to receive a broadcast or fixed wireless signal transmitted over |

| 1 | the air, and includes a dish antenna, a television antenna, and a wireless cable |
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| 2 | antenna. |
| 3 | (2) "Operator" means a person who owns, controls, operates, manages, |
| 4 | or leases a cable television system, satellite system, wireless cable system, or |
| 5 | any other system involving the transmission and reception of a broadcast or |
| 6 | fixed wireless signal. |
| 7 | (3) "Owner" means a person who possesses legal title to real property, |
| 8 | some or all of which is leased to a tenant. |
| 9 | (b) Installation. Subject to subsection (c) of this section: |
| 10 | (1) An operator who agrees to install an antenna on real property |
| 11 | pursuant to an agreement with a tenant of the property shall not install the |
| 12 | antenna without the owner's prior written consent. |
| 13 | (2) An owner may refuse his or her consent for good cause only. |
| 14 | (3) For purposes of this subsection, good cause includes: |
| 15 | (A) The operator failed to honor a previous written contractual |
| 16 | commitment. |
| 17 | (B) The operator failed to maintain or remove an antenna or repair |
| 18 | damage arising from a prior installation. |
| 19 | (C) The installation raises a reasonable safety concern. |
| 20 | (D) The installation adversely impacts a significant historic feature of |
| 21 | the property. |

| 1 | (c) Installation without owner's prior consent. An operator may install an |
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| 2 | antenna without the owner's prior written consent if prior to the installation the |
| 3 | operator delivers to the owner, in person or by certified mail, return receipt |
| 4 | requested by the addressee, the following: |
| 5 | (1) a copy of this section; |
| 6 | (2) a signed statement that the operator is bound by the terms of this |
| 7 | section to the owner of the property; |
| 8 | (3) notice to the owner in clear, plain language that describes the |
| 9 | owner's rights and responsibilities; and |
| 10 | (4) a work plan, including possible dates and specifications for the |
| 11 | installation. |
| 12 | (d) Requirements. An operator who installs an antenna on an owner's |
| 13 | property is subject to the following requirements: |
| 14 | (1) Unless waived in writing by the owner, the operator, prior to |
| 15 | installation, shall provide the owner with a certificate of insurance covering all |
| 16 | the employees or agents of the installer or operator, as well as all equipment of |
| 17 | the operator, and the operator shall indemnify the owner from all liability |
| 18 | arising from the operator's installation, maintenance, and operation of an |
| 19 | antenna. |
| 20 | (2) The operator shall install the antenna at no cost to the owner. |

| 1 | (3)(A) The operator shall abide by reasonable installation requests made |
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| 2 | by the owner. |
| 3 | (B) In a legal action, the burden of proof relative to the reasonable |
| 4 | nature of the owner's request is on the operator. |
| 5 | (4) Upon the owner's request, the operator shall inspect the premises |
| 6 | with the owner after the installation to ensure conformance with the work plan. |
| 7 | (5) The operator is responsible for maintaining and removing any |
| 8 | equipment installed on the owner's premises and is entitled to reasonable |
| 9 | access for those purposes. |
| 10 | (6) The operator shall not interfere with the safety, functioning, |
| 11 | appearance, or use of the property, or with the rules of the owner dealing with |
| 12 | the day-to-day operations of the property, including the owner's reasonable |
| 13 | access rules for soliciting business. |
| 14 | (e) Prohibition. An operator shall not enter into an agreement with a |
| 15 | person who owns, leases, controls, or manages a building, or perform any act |
| 16 | that would directly or indirectly diminish or interfere with the rights of any |
| 17 | tenant to use a master or individual antenna system. |
| 18 | (f) Nondiscrimination. A person who owns, leases, controls, or manages a |
| 19 | property may not discriminate in rental or other charges between tenants who |
| 20 | subscribe to services that require an antenna and those who do not, or demand |
| 21 | or accept payment in any form to affix an antenna on the property, except that |

- an owner may require reasonable payment from an operator in exchange for
- 2 permitting the installation of an antenna.
