7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to prohibit the
8	Agency of Transportation from charging rent to an owner or to an occupant of
9	a residence located on State rail property if certain conditions are satisfied.

11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

16	(a)(1) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of \underline{in} this section, or
17	as otherwise provided by law, leases or licenses negotiated by the Agency
18	under 5 V.S.A. §§ 204 and 3405 and section 26 and subsection 1703(d) of this
19	title ordinarily shall require the payment of fair market value rent, as
20	determined by the prevailing area market prices for comparable space or

1	property. However, the Agency may lease or license State-owned property
2	under its jurisdiction for less than fair market value when the Agency
3	determines that the proposed occupancy or use serves a public purpose or that
4	there exist other relevant factors, such as a prior course of dealing between the
5	parties, that justify setting rent at less than fair market value.
6	(2) The Agency shall not charge rent to an owner or to an occupant of a
7	residence located on State rail property if the Agency has not charged rent
8	during 15 or more years of its continuous occupancy as a residence and if the
9	residence is a registered historic place. However, the Agency may require the
10	owner or occupant of the property, or both, to adhere to standard terms and
11	conditions contained in rail property lease agreements.
