Subject: Public property and supplies; public printing; legislative directory

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require that the legislative directory prepared by the Secretary of State be posted on the Secretary of State's website and no longer to require the printing and distribution of paper copies.

An act relating to the legislative directory prepared by the Secretary of State

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 22 V.S.A. § 601 is amended to read:

§ 601. APPOINTMENT OF STATE LIBRARIAN; POWERS AND DUTIES

\* \* \*

(c) The State Librarian shall distribute, in accordance with 29 V.S.A. §§ 1152-1163 and 1191-1193a and other official lists maintained by the State Librarian, the Acts and Resolves of the General Assembly, ~~the legislative directory~~, the Vermont Statutes Annotated, the Vermont key number digest, the journals of the Senate and House of Representatives, the Vermont reports,

1 and other official reports and documents. The State Librarian shall maintain  
2 records of all documents ~~which~~ that he or she distributes.
