19	(b) The Commissioner shall furnish the items listed in subsection (a) of thi		
20	section only upon a request which completely identifies the information		

1	sought. Completely identifying the information sought for individuals shall	
2	mean name and date of birth, and for vehicles it shall mean either the	
3	registration number or the vehicle identification number. To qualify for a fee	
4	exemption under subsection (c) of this section, a qualifying organization must	
5	provide the Commissioner information sufficient to enable him or her to	
6	determine eligibility.	
7	(c)(1) As used in this section:	
8	(A) "Formal mentoring services" means the provision of mentoring	
9	services on a volunteer basis by an adult 18 years of age or older to a child	
10	under 18 years of age.	
11	(B) "Qualifying organization" means a nonprofit organization that	
12	has tax-exempt status under 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3) and that supports the	
13	provision of formal mentoring services in Vermont.	
14	(2) A qualifying organization shall be exempt from the fee specified in	
15	subdivision (a)(20) of this section with respect to its request for a complete	
16	operating record in order to screen applicant or existing volunteers who may or	
17	do transport children as part of providing formal mentoring services.
