4	Subject: Agriculture; pollinator protection; pesticides
5	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require a
6	person who sells treated article corn or soybean seed in the State to offer for
7	sale untreated corn or soybean seed. The bill also requires the Secretary of
8	Agriculture, Food and Markets to assess the effect of neonicotinoid-treated
9	seeds on pollinator losses in the State. The bill also requires the Secretary of
10	Agriculture, Food and Markets to develop and implement an educational
11	program to inform users of pesticides in the State of the effects of pesticides
12	on pollinators.
13	An act relating to the protection of pollinators
14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
15	* * * Treated Article Seed; Untreated Seed * * *
16	Sec. 1. 6 V.S.A. § 641 is amended to read:
17	§ 641. DEFINITIONS
18	As used in this chapter:
19	(1) "Agricultural seed" includes grass, forage, cereal, oil, fiber, and

1	other kinds of crop seeds commonly recognized as agricultural seeds, lawn
2	seeds, and combinations of such seeds, and may include noxious weed seeds
3	used as agricultural seed.
4	(2) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets
5	or his or her designee.
6	(3) "Agency" means the Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets.
7	(4) "Flower seed" includes seed of herbaceous plants grown for their
8	blooms, ornamental foliage, or other ornamental parts, and commonly known
9	and sold under the name of flower seed.
10	* * *
11	(7) "Vegetable seeds" include the seeds of those crops which that are
12	grown in gardens and on truck farms and are generally known and sold under
13	the name of vegetable or herb seeds in this State.
14	* * *
15	(11) "Treated article pesticide" shall have the same meaning as "treated
16	article" in section 1101 of this title.
17	(12) "Treated article corn or soybean seed" means a corn or soybean
18	seed that is a treated article pesticide.
19	(13) "Untreated corn or soybean seed" means corn or soybean seed that
20	is not a treated article pesticide.

Sec. 2. 6 V.S.A. chapter 35, subchapter 3 is added to read:

1	Subchapter 3. Seed Supply; Untreated Corn or Soybean Seed
2	§ 650. SEED SUPPLY; UNTREATED CORN OR SOYBEAN SEED
3	A person who sells treated article corn or soybean seed in the State shall
4	offer for sale untreated corn or soybean seed. As used in this section, "offer
5	for sale" includes arranging for or taking orders for the delivery of untreated
6	corn or soybean seed.
7	Sec. 3. IMPLEMENTATION OF REQUIREMENT TO OFFER
8	UNTREATED CORN OR SOYBEAN SEED
9	A person shall be required to offer untreated corn or soybean seed for sale
10	under 6 V.S.A. § 650 beginning on July 1, 2018 for the purpose of use during
11	the planting season in 2019.
12	Sec. 4. AGENCY OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD AND MARKETS REPORT
13	ON IMPACT OF NEONICOTINOID-TREATED SEEDS ON
14	POLLINATORS
15	(a) The Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets (Secretary) shall assess
16	the effect of neonicotinoid-treated seeds on the loss of pollinator populations in
17	Vermont by independently reviewing claims of pollinator losses by
18	beekeepers. On or before January 15, 2019, the Secretary shall submit to the
19	House Committee on Agriculture and Forestry and the Senate Committee on
20	Agriculture the results of the assessment of pollinator losses. The report shall
21	include:

(1) data collected by the Secretary regarding pollinator losses in the
State, provided that the data shall be provided in an aggregated form that does
not disclose the identity of individual persons, households, or businesses from
whom the data were obtained;
(2) the causes of pollinator losses;
(3) an assessment of whether neonicotinoid-treated seeds caused or
contributed to any pollinator losses in Vermont; and
(4) recommendations, if any, for preventing pollinator losses in
<u>Vermont.</u>
(b) As used in this section:
(1) "Economic poison" shall have the same meaning as in 6 V.S.A.
<u>§ 911.</u>
(2) "Neonicotinoid pesticide" means any economic poison containing a
chemical belonging to the neonicotinoid class of chemicals.
(3) "Neonicotinoid-treated seed" means agricultural seed treated with a
neonicotinoid pesticide.
Sec. 5. EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN; PESTICIDES AND POLLINATORS
The Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets shall develop and
implement an educational program to inform users of pesticides in the State of
the effects of pesticides on pollinators and methods or techniques for
mitigating the effects of pesticides on pollinators. The Secretary of
