Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to approve  
amendments to the charter of the Town of Colchester.

An act relating to approval of amendments to the charter of the Town of  
Colchester

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. CHARTER AMENDMENT APPROVAL

The General Assembly approves the amendments to the charter of the Town  
of Colchester as set forth in this act. Voters approved the proposals of  
amendment on March 6, 2018.

Sec. 2. 24 App. V.S.A. chapter 113 is amended to read:

CHAPTER 113. TOWN OF COLCHESTER

§ 202. ELECTIVE OFFICERS; GENERALLY

1 (a) At the annual meeting, the Town shall elect by Australian ballot from  
2 among the legally qualified voters thereof the following Town officers, who  
3 shall serve until the next annual meeting or until others are chosen.

4 \* \* \*

5 ~~(3) A Town Clerk and Treasurer for a term of two years.~~

6 (4) One Lister for a term of three years.

7 ~~(5)~~(4) A Library Trustee for a term of five years.

8 (b) In such case as three or more candidates run for the same office and no  
9 candidate receives at least 40 percent of the votes cast for said office, no one  
10 shall be declared elected and a run-off election shall be held. The only  
11 candidates in the run-off election shall be the two persons receiving the  
12 greatest number of votes for that office. The Town Clerk shall within ~~7~~ seven  
13 days warn a run-off election to be held not less than 15 nor more than 30 days  
14 after the date of the warning. The person receiving a plurality of all votes cast  
15 in a run-off election shall be declared elected.
