5	(3) A Town Clerk and Treasurer for a term of two years.
6	(4) One Lister for a term of three years.
7	(5)(4) A Library Trustee for a term of five years.
8	(b) In such case as three or more candidates run for the same office and no

10	shall be declared elected and a run-off election shall be held. The only
