Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to repeal the law
permitting the Commissioner of Labor to suspend certain child labor laws
while the United States is at war.

An act relating to the repeal of 21 V.S.A. § 6

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 21 V.S.A. § 6 is amended to read:

§ 6. ~~DUTY WHEN UNITED STATES AT WAR~~

~~With the approval of the Governor, the Commissioner of Labor may
suspend the operation of the laws relating to the hours of employment of
women and children while the United States is at war. [Repealed.]~~

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
