14	Upon receipt of an application for license and the license fee, the licensing
15	agency shall issue a license when it determines that the applicant and hospital
16	facilities meet the following minimum standards:

18	(10) All employees shall have a pre-employment physical examination
19	preemployment screening by a licensed physician or a qualified nurse

1	practitioner, licensed physician assistant, or licensed advanced practice
2	registered nurse who is acting within his or her scope of practice, or by a
3	designee acting under the direction of one of these licensed health care
4	professionals. This examination screening shall include medically indicated
5	radiological, hematological, biochemical, immunological, or serological
6	examinations screenings to exclude the presence of a communicable disease
7	prior to employment. These examinations screenings may be repeated
8	annually as a condition of employment and the results shall be made available
9	on request, to the licensing agency for review.
