14	§ 707. NONPROFIT RECIPIENTS OF STATE FUNDING; LIMITATION
15	ON EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION
16	(a) Unless it receives a waiver from the Secretary of Administration
17	pursuant to subsection (b) of this section, for any fiscal year in which a
18	nonprofit organization receives a total of \$1,000,000.00 or more in State
19	funding, including through one or more direct or indirect appropriations, pass-
20	through grants of federal or State funds or any other form of transfer from the

1	State, the organization shall not provide to any of its officers, directors, or
2	employees total compensation that exceeds the compensation specified for the
3	Governor of Vermont in that fiscal year.
4	(b) The Secretary of Administration shall have the authority to collect
5	information to verify compliance with this section from nonprofit
6	organizations that receive State funding and to adopt rules and procedures to
7	collect such information and evaluate and approve requests for waivers from
8	the limitation imposed in subsection (a) of this section.
9	(c) If the Secretary determines that a nonprofit organization violates
10	subsection (a) of this section, the organization shall be ineligible for State
11	funding for two consecutive years following the year in which the violation
12	occurred.
