12	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
13	Sec. 1. COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY; PLAN FOR THE
14	CREATION OF THE AGENCY OF PUBLIC SAFETY
15	(a)(1) On or before January 1, 2019, the Commissioner of Public Safety
16	shall submit to the Senate and House Committees on Government Operations a
17	proposed plan to elevate the Department of Public Safety to the Agency of
18	Public Safety in accordance with a potential hierarchical structure for the
19	Agency described in subsection (b) of this section.

1	(2) That potential structure for the Agency described in subsection (b)
2	would maintain all of the Department's current functions, but would also
3	transfer to the new Agency of Public Safety:
4	(A) the Vermont Criminal Justice Training Council, the Vermont Fire
5	Service Training Council, and the Robert H. Wood, Jr. Criminal Justice and
6	Fire Service Training Center of Vermont;
7	(B) from the Office of the Sergeant at Arms, the management of
8	Capitol Police officers;
9	(C) from various State entities, the management of all State law
10	enforcement officers;
11	(D) from the Department of State's Attorneys and Sheriffs, the
12	management of sheriffs' departments and the coordination of special
13	investigative units;
14	(E) the Department of Liquor Control;
15	(F) the State Lottery Commission; and
16	(G) from the Agency of Human Services, the Department of
17	Corrections, including its programs regarding probation and parole.
18	(3) The Commissioner's proposed plan shall include his or her:
19	(A) recommendations on how to make the transition to that structure,
20	including any specific timing recommendations; and
21	(B) concerns, if any, regarding the structure.
