6	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to provide that
7	nutrient management plans that the Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets
8	finances, has access to, or produces or acquires are public records subject to
9	inspection and copying under the Public Records Act.
10	An act relating to public access to nutrient management plans
11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 6 V.S.A. § 4829 is added to read:
13	§ 4829. NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLANS; PUBLIC RECORD
14	(a) Notwithstanding the authority of the Secretary of Agriculture, Food and
15	Markets to withhold identifying information under section 61 of this title, and
16	except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a nutrient management
17	plan required under this chapter shall be available for public inspection and
18	copying under the Public Records Act if one or more of the following apply:
19	(1) the nutrient management plan was produced in whole or in part with
20	financial assistance provided under this chapter:

1	(2) the Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets has access to the
2	nutrient management plan for purposes of inspection or enforcement under this
3	chapter or rules adopted under this chapter; or
4	(3) the Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets has produced or
5	acquired the nutrient management plan.
6	(b) When the Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets receives a
7	request under subsection (a) of this section to inspect or copy a nutrient
8	management plan, the Secretary shall redact information that is protected from
9	disclosure to the public under 7 U.S.C. § 8791 or other provision of law.
10	(c) Notwithstanding the requirement under 1 V.S.A. § 318(a)(2) that a
11	public agency respond to a public records request within three business days
12	from the receipt of the request, the Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets
13	shall produce a nutrient management plan requested under this section for
14	inspection or copying or shall certify denial of the request within 10 business
15	days from the receipt of the request.
16	(d) A nutrient management plan is not confidential business information or
17	a trade secret under 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(9) of the Public Records Act.

19	§ 4827. NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLANNING; INCENTIVE GRANTS
20	(a) A farm developing or implementing a nutrient management plan under
21	chapter 215 of this title or federal regulations may apply to the Secretary of

Agriculture, Food and Markets for financial assistance. The financial
assistance shall be in the form of incentive grants. Annually, after consultation
with the Natural Resources Conservation Service of the U.S. Department of
Agriculture, natural resources conservation districts, the University of Vermont
Extension Service and others, the Secretary shall determine the average cost of
developing and implementing a nutrient management plan in Vermont. The
dollar amount of an incentive grant awarded under this section shall be equal to
the average cost of developing a nutrient management plan as determined by
the Secretary or the cost of complying with the nutrient management planning
requirements of chapter 215 of this title or federal regulations, whichever
is less.

(h) The Secretary may inspect any nutrient management plan financed
under this section or any other State assistance program.
