Information Notice Drafting Request Deadline

Pursuant to Rule 40(a):

During the first year of the biennium:

- (1) Except with the prior consent of the Committee on Rules, no member may introduce a bill drafted in standard form unless he or she submits the request to the Office of Legislative Council on or before the last legislative day of January and approves the bill for public release on or before the fourth legislative day before the end of February.
- (2) A member may submit a request to the Office of Legislative Council for a bill to be drafted in standard form relating to the adoption or amendment of a municipal charter or to the approval of a municipal merger at any time and may introduce such a bill at any time.
- (3) A member may submit a request to the Office of Legislative Council for a bill to be drafted in short form at any time and may introduce such a bill at any time.
