An act relating to extending the current expiration date of the telecommunications siting law

Rep. Carr of Brandon, for the Committee on Energy and Technology, recommends the bill be amended by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 1. 30 V.S.A. § 248a is amended to read:

§ 248a. CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD FOR COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES

* * *

(i) ~~Sunset of Board authority. Effective on July 1, 2017, no new applications for certificates of public good under this section may be considered by the Board. [Repealed.]~~

* * *

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.

and that after passage the title of the bill be amended to read: “An act relating to removing the expiration of the telecommunications siting law”
