

PURPOSE OF THE FORUMS



- Since the deliberation of Act 250 in the Spring of 1970, this land-use law has provided development regulations to preserve Vermont's landscape.
- Through its almost fifty-year history, Act 250 has received some alterations.
- The Legislative Commission is seeking citizen input to better meet the needs of the State for the next fifty years.

THE BEGINNING OF ACT 250



In 1970, Governor Deane Davis signed Act 250 into law, "in order to protect and serve the lands and the environment of the state and to insure that these lands and environment are devoted to uses which are not detrimental to the public welfare and interests."



ACT 250 ESSENTIALS

BACKGROUND & HISTORY

- Act 250 allows for economic growth while protecting
 Vermont's air, water & wildlife.
- Permit decisions to be determined in districts to allow for local character and culture.








KEY FACTS

- Act 250 regulates and controls development
- Act 250 protects the environment
- Decisions are based on 10 criteria such as preventing undue water or air pollution, not having undue adverse effects on natural areas, or imperil wildlife habitats, and more.
- Act 250 hearings are conducted by a 3-member District Environmental Commission who have been appointed by the Governor.
- All parties have the right to an appeal.

ACT 250'S CITIZEN-BASED REVIEW PROCESS






ACT 250 MYTHS

(What Act 250 is Not)

- The legislation is not a planning tool.
- Act 250 is not the sole determinant of land use.
- The legislation does not favor one criterion over another.
- Act 250 does not favor competitors over one another.




The Big Deal™: Public Policy Influencing
