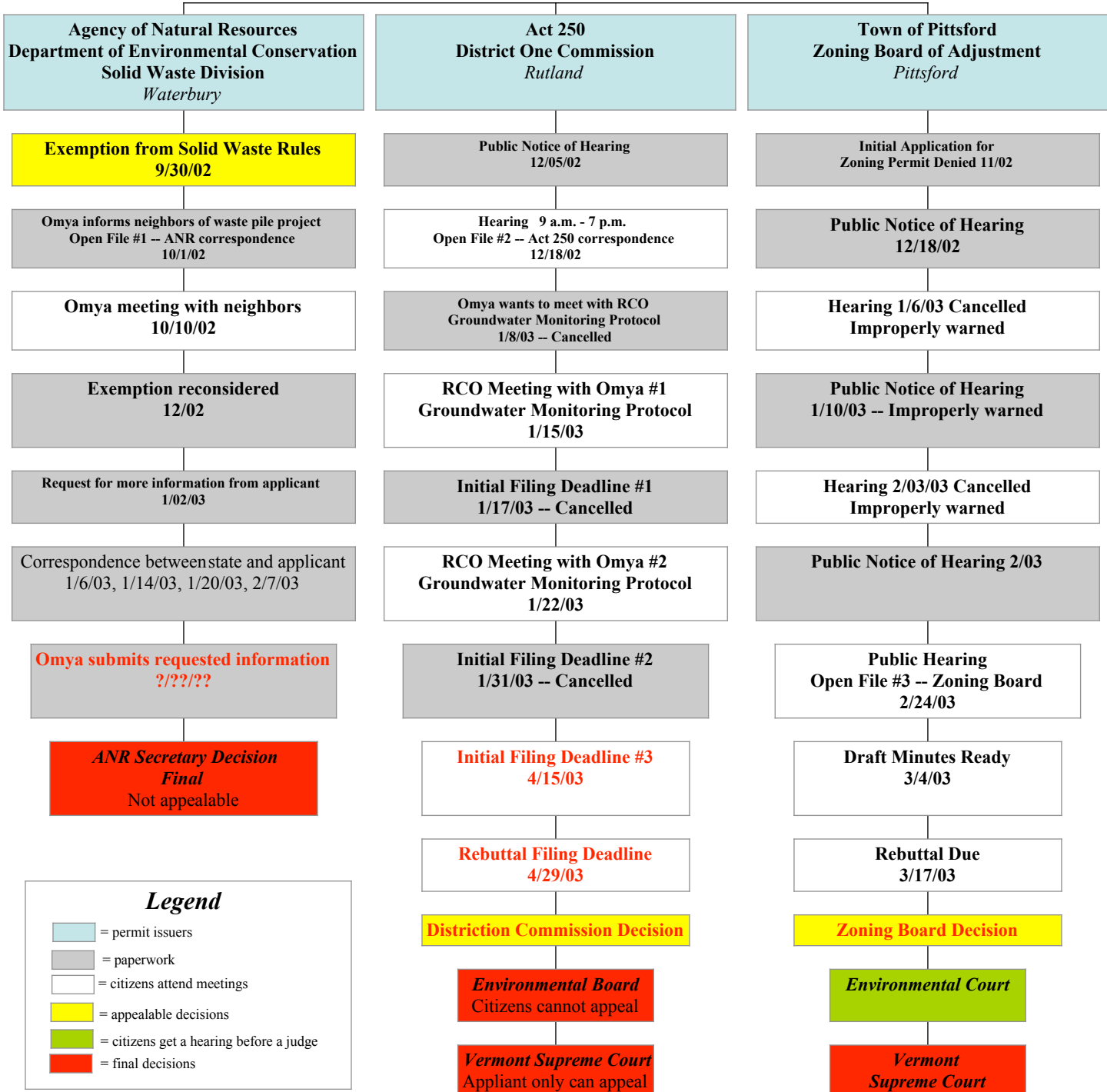


The Permit Process for a 32 Acre Waste Pile that contains Chemicals and is located close to private wells and a public water supply

Vermont Solid Waste Management Rules: §6-301(b)(2):
May these materials pose a threat to public health and safety, the environment, or cause a nuisance?

Act 250 10 VSA §6086(a)(1)(B): Waste Disposal: Demonstrate that the project will meet any applicable health or environmental conservation department regulations regarding the disposal of wastes and demonstrate that the project will not involve the injection of wastes or toxic substances into ground waters.

Local Zoning §2.12.1(b):
Will the project cause any unreasonable hazard to or impact upon health, property or property values through fire, unsanitary conditions, erosion, noise, air or water pollution?
