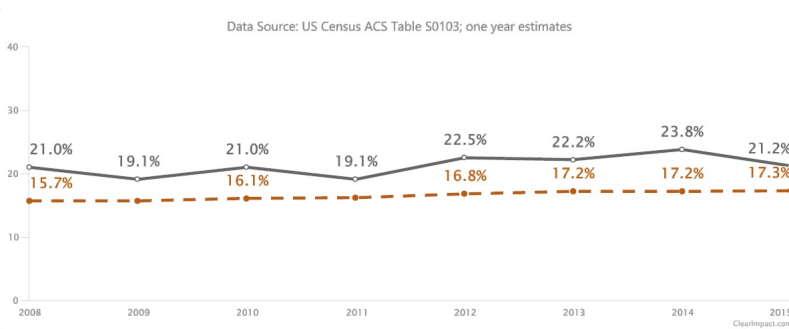

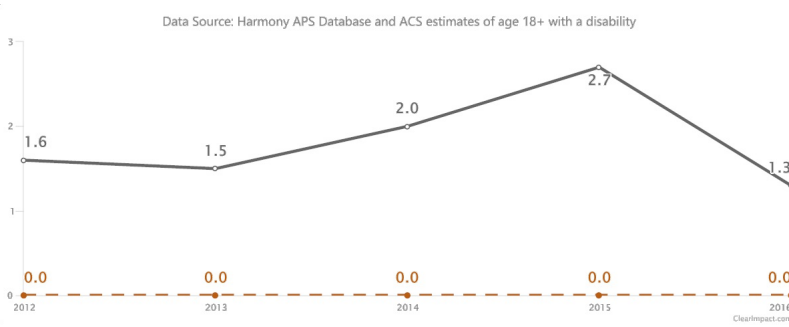

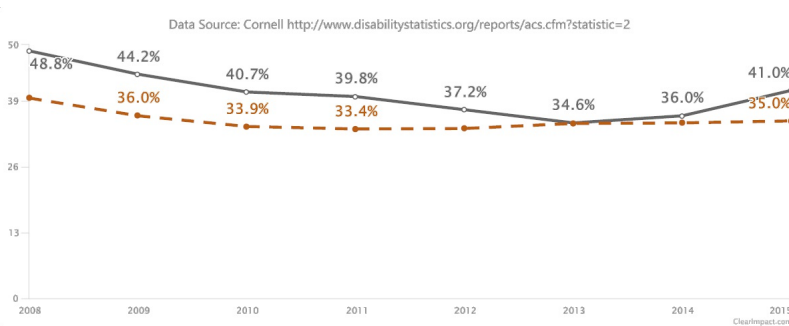

I Act 186 Estimated employment rate of Vermonters age 21-64 with all disabilities



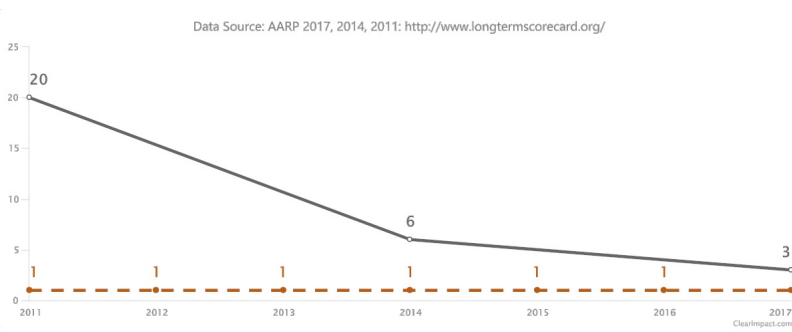

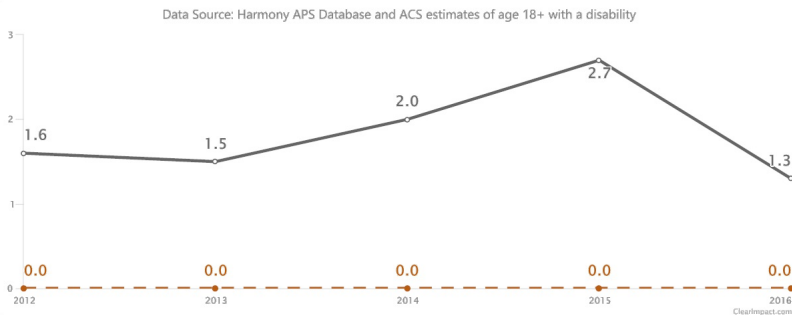

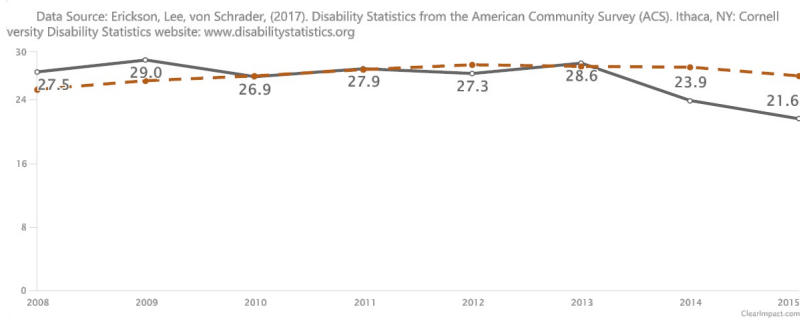

DLP Rate of confirmed reports of abuse, neglect and exploitation of vulnerable adults per 1,000 vulnerable adults



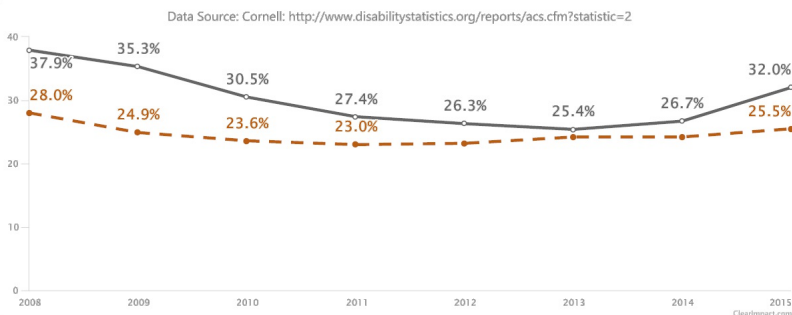

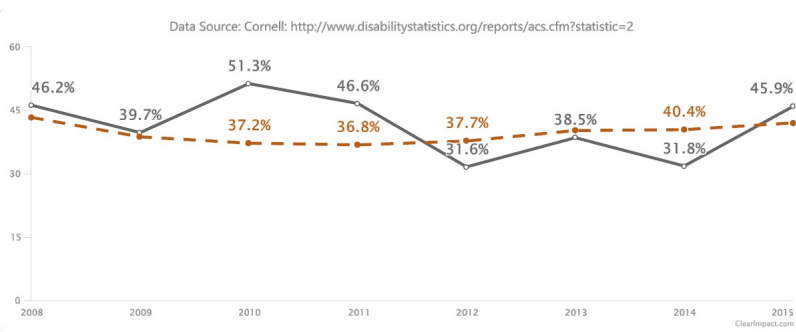

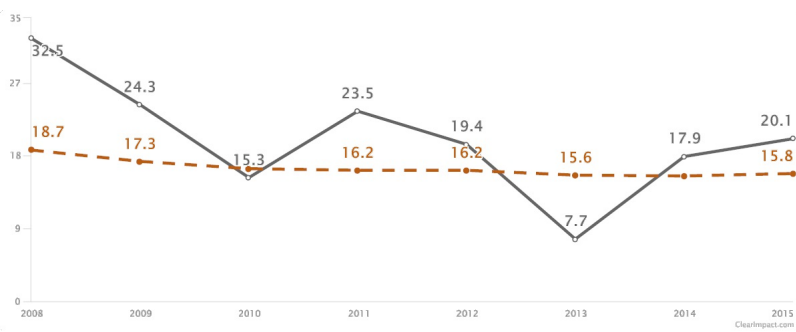

Employment Estimated employment rate of Vermonters age 21-64 with a self-care disability



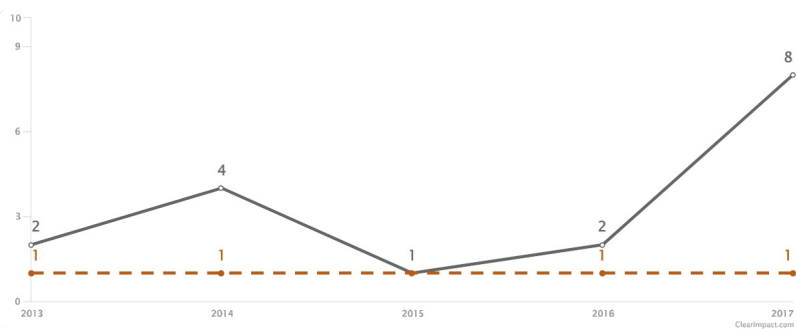

Older Adults Vermont Senior Health Ranking (United Health Foundation)

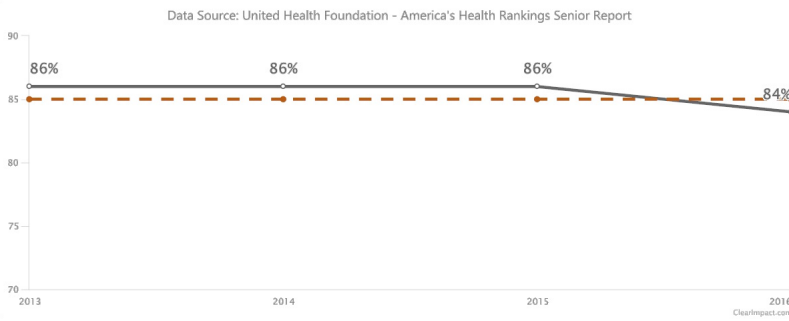

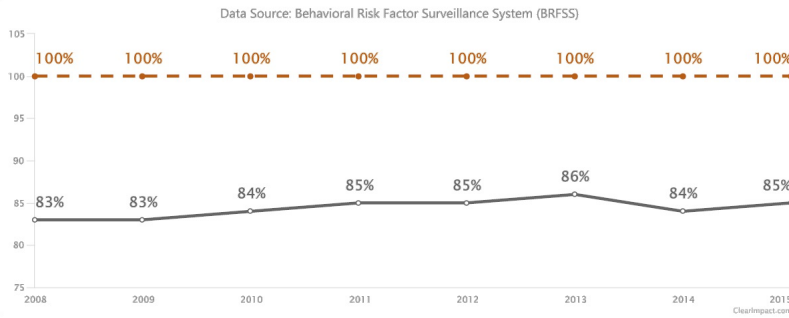
HV2020 Percent of adults age 65 and older with prescription drug coverage

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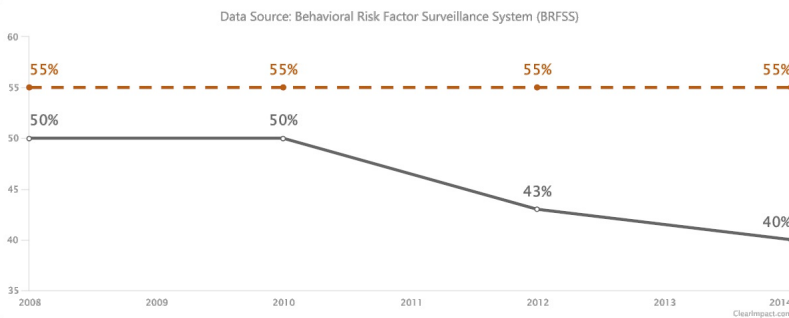

I VDH Older Adults % of adults age 65 and older who visited a doctor in the last year for routine care



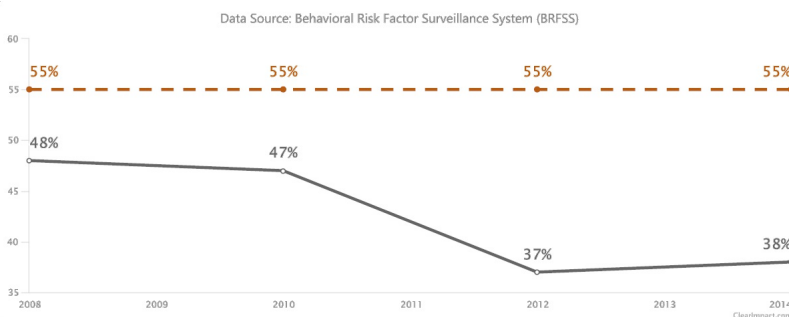

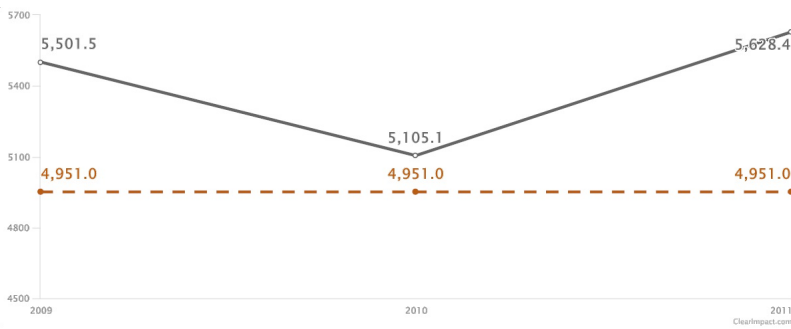
I VDH Older Adults % of females age 65 and older who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventive services

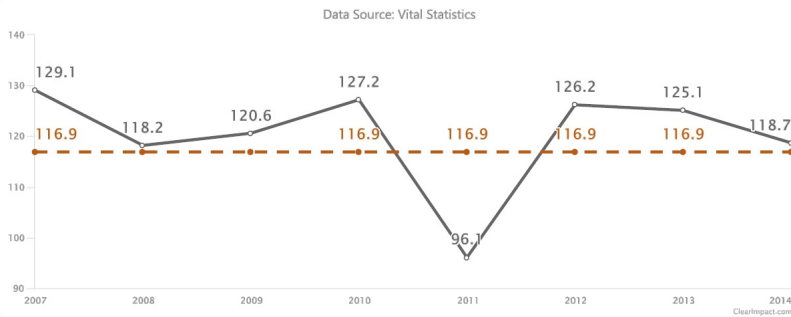
Fall-related emergency department visits per 100,000

VDH Injury adults age 65 and older



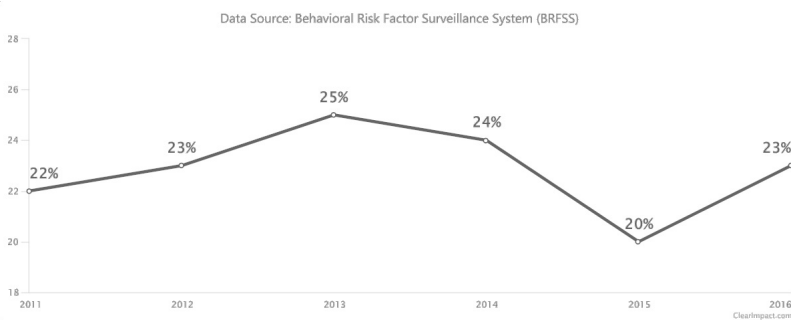

VDH Injury Fall-related death rate per 100,000 adults age 65 and older



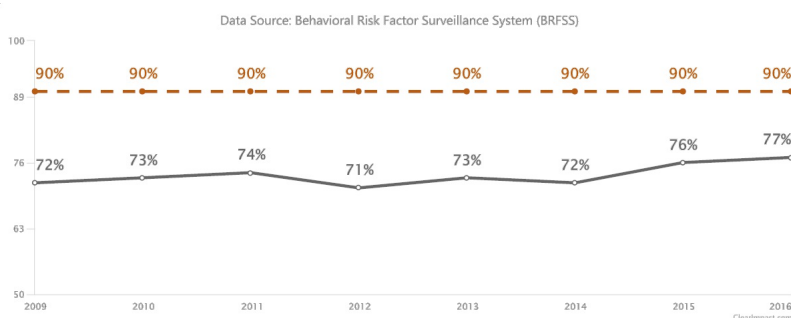

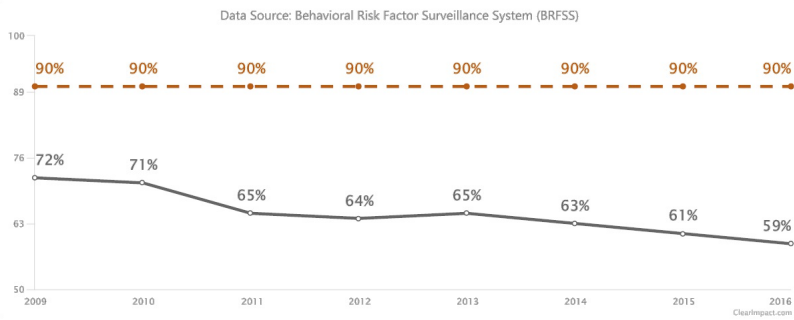
VDH Immunization % of adults age 65 and older who ever had pneumococcal vaccine

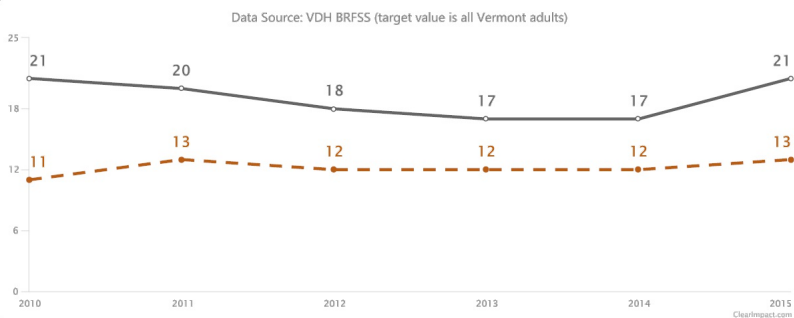

I VDH Immunization % of adults age 65 and older who receive annual flu shot



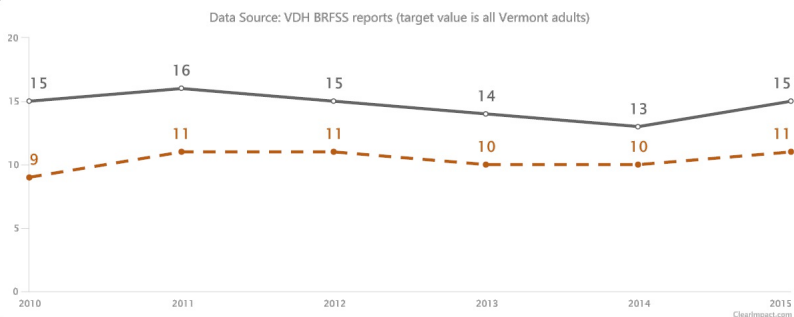

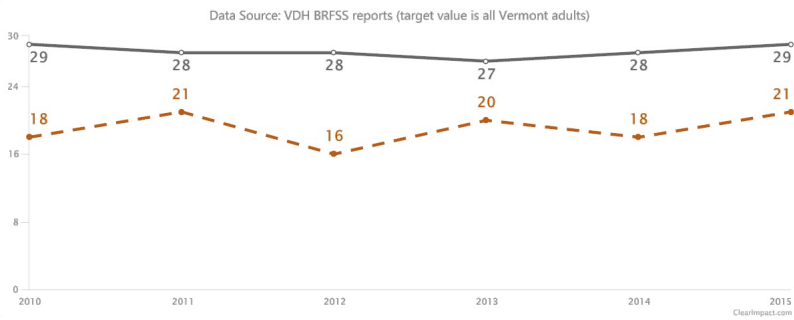

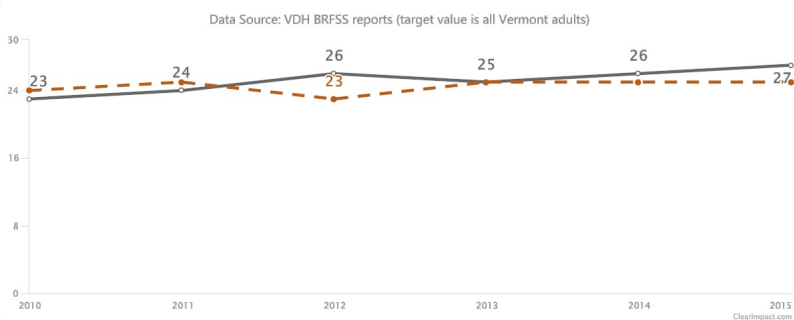

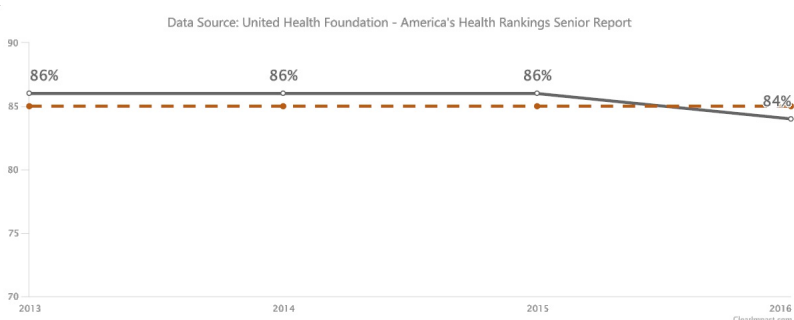

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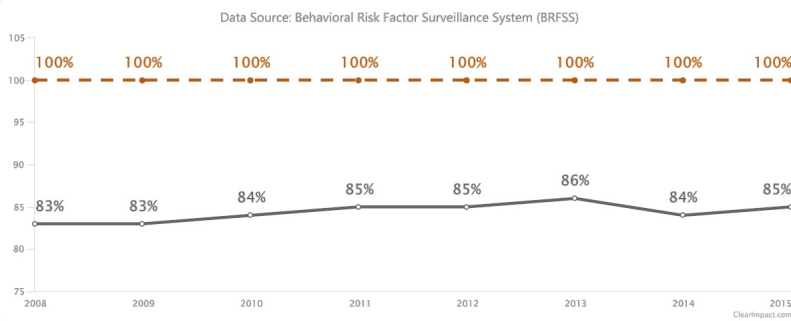
I HV2020 Percent of adults age 65 and older with prescription drug coverage

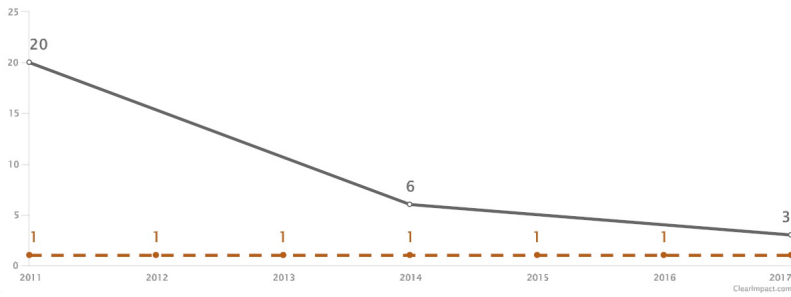

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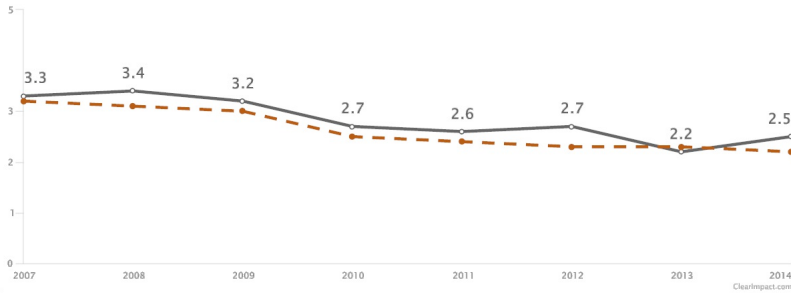

I Act 186 Persons 60+ Living in Nursing Homes and Other Institutions as a % of All Persons 60+; Target Value is US rate

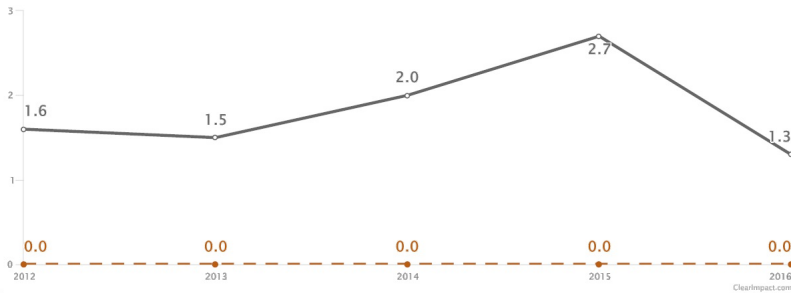

I DLP Rate of confirmed reports of abuse, neglect and exploitation of vulnerable adults per 1,000 vulnerable adults

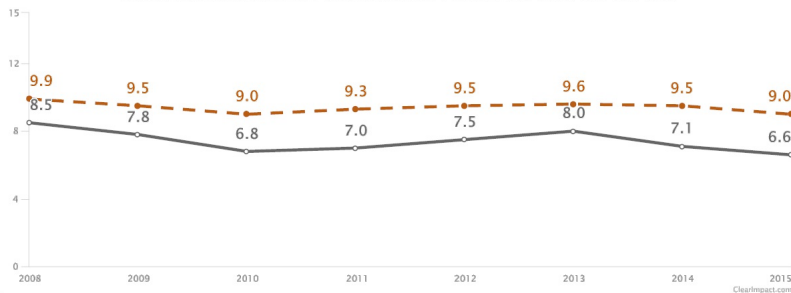

I Older Adults Percentage of Vermonters age 65+ living in poverty

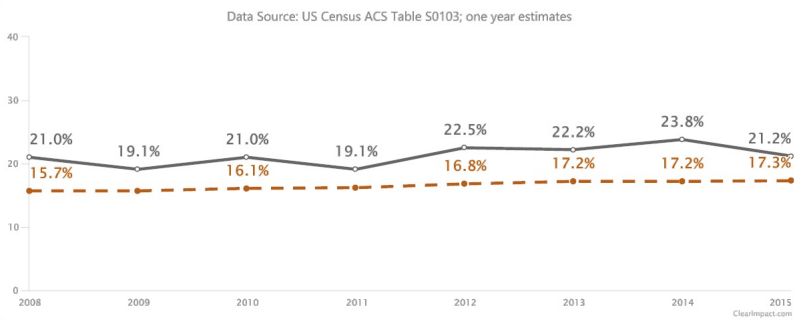

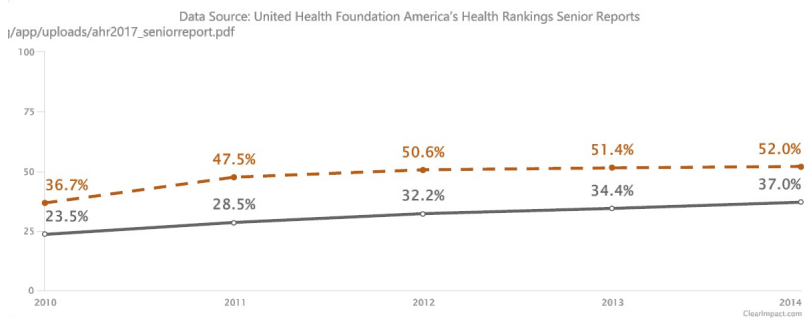
