Hi GAC Co-Chairs,

The House Committee on Corrections and Institutions discussed <u>your Jan. 3rd letter</u> that sought committee feedback on the indicators within each committee's jurisdiction.

The Committee focused on Outcome 4 (Vermont is a safe place to live) as an outcome within its jurisdiction.

The Committee submits these two indicator proposals for Outcome 4:

- 1) By amending current Indicator (F) to read: "number of first-time entrants coming into the corrections system."
- 2) By adding a new Indicator (G) to read: "number of first-time entrants with an opioid disorder coming into the corrections system [placeholder]."

The proposed new indicator is a placeholder because the data is not currently being collected. However, the Committee thinks it is important information to start to track because of the impact opioids have on the safety of Vermont.
