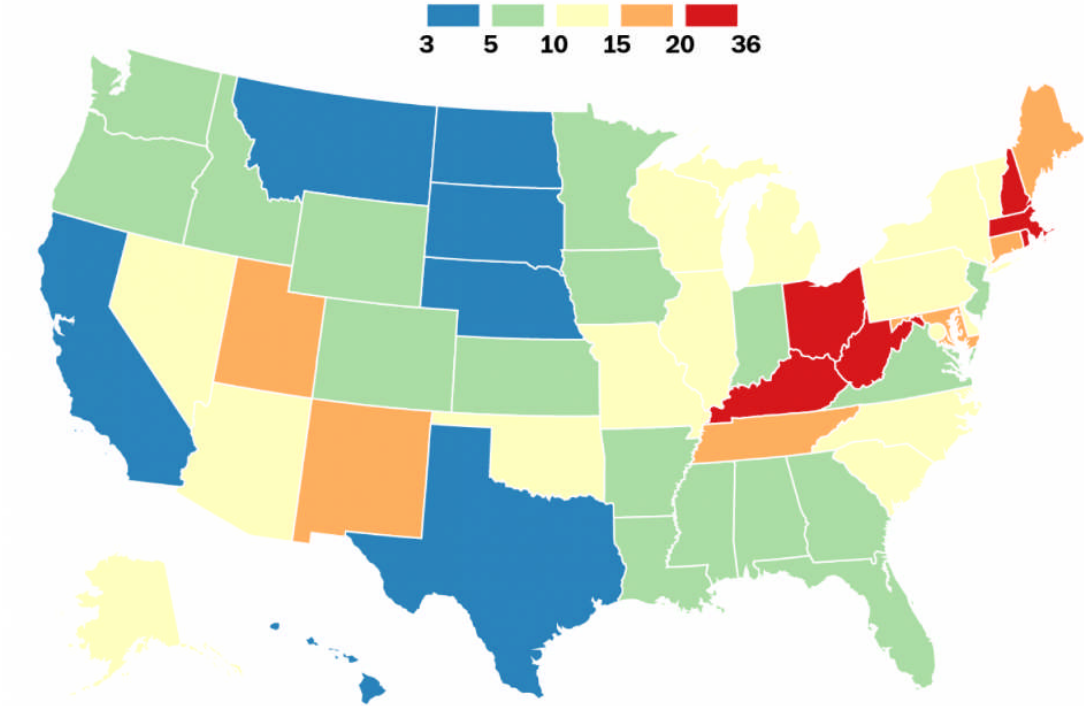


# Overall Opioid 2015 Death Rate by State

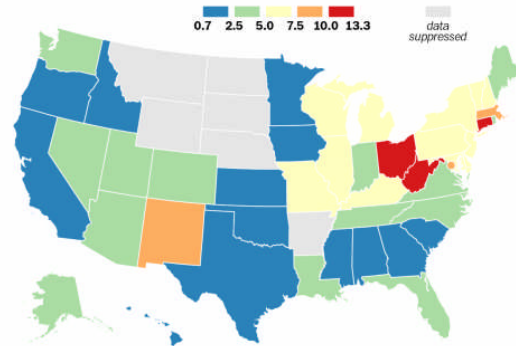
# 2015 Death Rate by State and Opioid Type

Natural Opioid: “classic” opioid painkillers such as hydrocodone and oxycodone

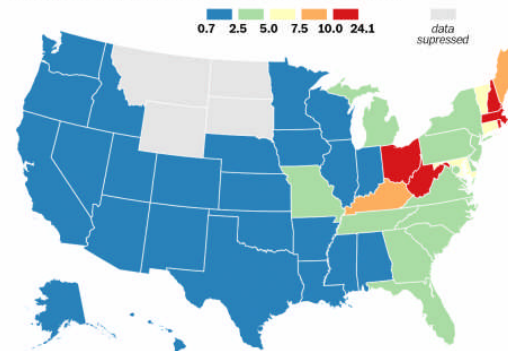
## Heroin deaths in 2015

Age-adjusted heroin overdose death rate (per 100,000)



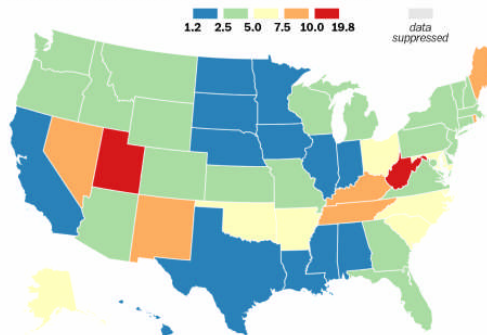
## Synthetic opioid deaths in 2015

## Natural opioid deaths in 2015

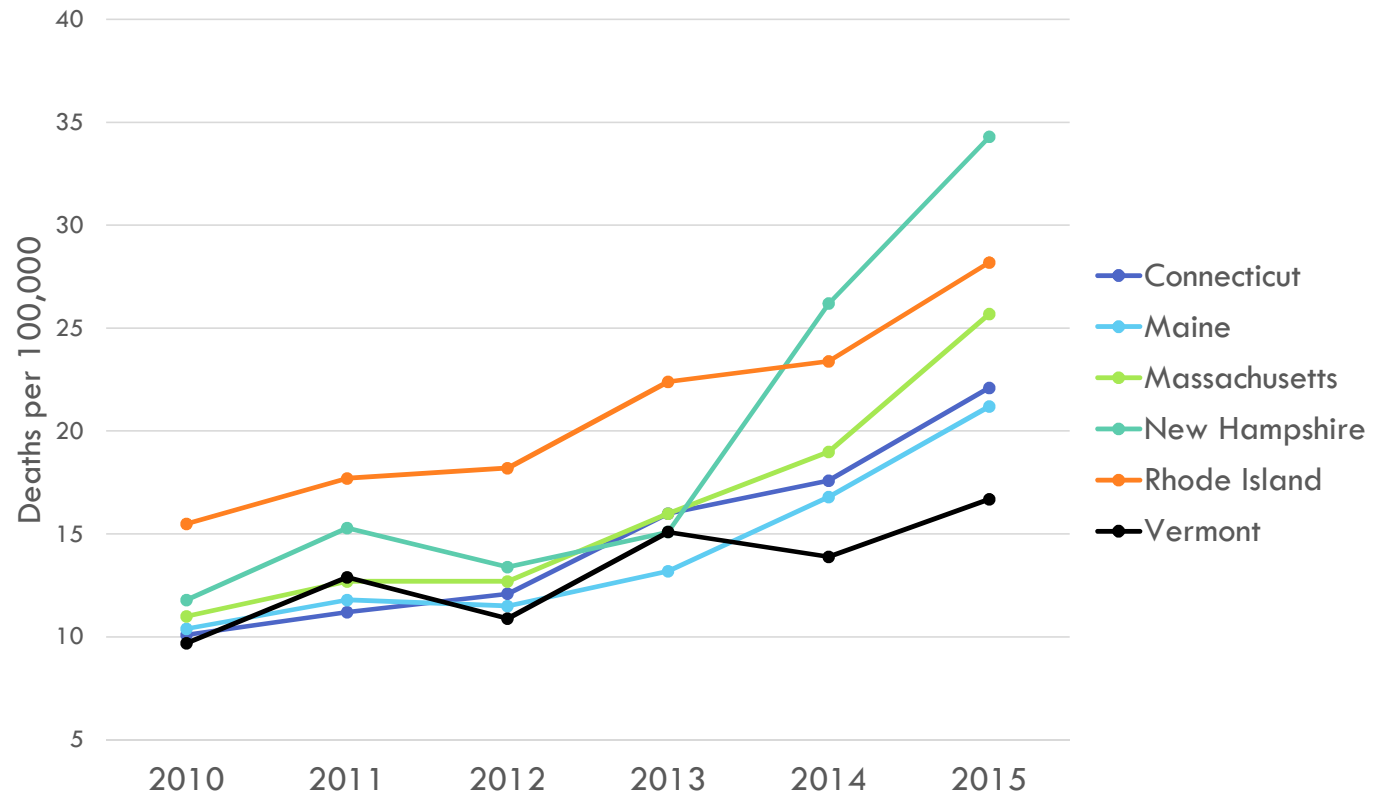
Age-adjusted natural opioid overdose death rate (per 100,000)

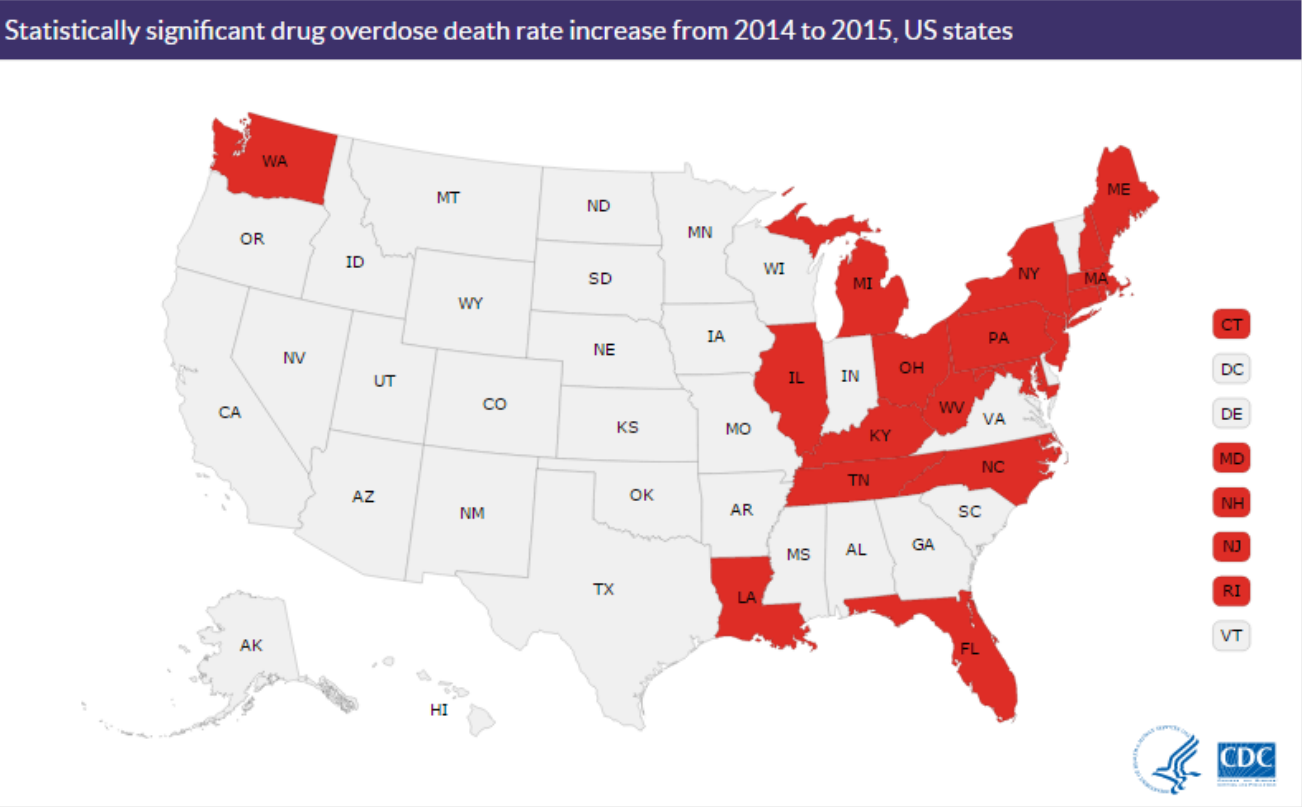
# New England Drug Overdose Deaths
