9	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to prohibit the
10	retention of any amount of payment due and owing for materials delivered for
11	a construction project.
12 13	An act relating to prohibiting the retention of any payment due and owing a material supplier for a construction project
14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
15	Sec. 1. 9 V.S.A. § 4005 is amended to read:
16	§ 4005. RETAINAGE
17	(a) If payments under a construction contract are subject to retainage, any
18	amounts which that have been retained during the performance of the contract
19	and which that are due to be released to the contractor upon final completion

shall be paid within 30 days after final acceptance of the work, not including

1	any payment for materials pertinent to the project that have been delivered,
2	accepted, and are covered by the manufacturer's warranty or graded to meet
3	industry standard, or both, except in the case of a materialman who is also
4	contracted to install a product he or she delivered.
5	(b) If an owner is not withholding retainage, a contractor may withhold
6	retainage from its subcontractor in accordance with their agreement. The
7	retainage shall be paid within 30 days after final acceptance of the work, not
8	including any payment for materials pertinent to the project that have been
9	delivered, accepted, and are covered by the manufacturer's warranty or graded
10	to meet industry standards, or both, except in the case of a materialman who is
11	also contracted to install a product he or she delivered.
