6	(a) No person, firm, or corporation shall refuse to employ any applicant for
7	employment because such the applicant asserted a claim for workers'
8	compensation benefits under this chapter or under the law of any state or of the
9	United States. Nothing in this section shall require a person to employ an
10	applicant who does not meet the qualifications of the position sought.
11	(b) No person shall discharge or discriminate against an employee from
12	employment because such the employee asserted or attempted to assert a claim
13	for benefits under this chapter or under the law of any state or of the United
14	States.
15	(c) The Department shall not include in any publication or public report the
16	name or contact information of any individual who has alleged that an
17	employer has made a false statement or misclassified any employees, unless it
18	is required by law or necessary to enable enforcement of this chapter.
19	(d) An employer shall not retaliate or take any other negative action against
20	an individual because the employer knows or suspects that the individual has
21	filed a complaint with the Department or other authority, or reported a

1	violation of this chapter, or <u>has testified</u> , <u>assisted</u> , <u>or</u> cooperated <u>in any manner</u>
2	with the Department or any other authority, including the Department of
3	Financial Regulation or an employer's insurance carrier, in an investigation of

5	(e) The Attorney General or a State's Attorney may enforce the provisions
6	of this section by restraining prohibited acts, seeking civil penalties, obtaining

8	accordance with the procedures established in 9 V.S.A. §§ 2458-2461 as
9	though discrimination under a violation of this section were an unfair act in
10	commerce.
