13	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
14	Sec. 1. FINDINGS
15	The General Assembly finds that the management and operation of a
16	correctional facility involves functions that are inherently governmental.
17	It further finds that issues of liability, accountability, and cost warrant
18	a prohibition of the ownership, operation, or management of correctional
19	facilities by for-profit contractors.

- 3 (a) On or after July 1, 2018, the State shall not contract with a for-profit

- 6 (b) This section shall not apply to:
- 7 (1) State work release centers or juvenile residential facilities that
- 8 provide separate care or special treatment centers operated in whole or part by

- 11 educational services, repair and maintenance contracts, or other services not
- 12 directly related to the ownership, management, or operation of security

- 15 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
