On the evening of April 22, 2016 Leo was doing chores when he was struck and killed by a passing car. The driver got out and looked, then drove away.



It was caught on video.

The driver had 41 prior convictions: 33 misdemeanors and 8 Felonies - 3 dui and 2 for leaving the scene of an accident. He and leo had been sparring for years.

The driver's mother called the police and told them that she had been driving.

Under vermont law,
Leo's killer is eligible for home detention while
awaiting trial.
