Any student may request a Portfolio Review by the Flexible Pathways Committee to present evidence of proficiency at the graduation level. Students may also present evidence that they need continued instructional opportunities beyond the traditional four year high school experience.

In cases of students eligible for special education, the Vermont Department of Education Special Education Regulations regarding Multi-Year Plans and graduation will apply.

Students entering the Life Program, an alternative learning program, must meet the requirement of twenty (20) units of credit. The specific unit requirements will be waived as per accreditation of the program by the state, with the exception of the Personalized Learning Process requirement. Students entering CVU following completion of grade 8 who have successfully completed programs of study identified as 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade subjects may earn placement in courses at the high school Code G17-CVU:

Graduation Requirements level. The high school may require proficiency examinations to waive designated pre-requisite courses.
