

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

The Franklin Northwest Supervisory Union has made a choice to actively pursue the provision of high-quality after school programming that can positively impact academic skills, school day attendance and reduce substance abuse.

The Crossroads After School Programs held in Franklin, Highgate, Sheldon, Swanton



and at MVU are programs specifically for middle school students. Started in January 2006, this program operates 30 weeks during the school

year. Six years ago, for our K-6 schools, FNWSU expanded programming to include Crossroads Explorers program for 2nd ~ 4th grades and the MVU AfterHours program for 9th - 12th grade students, following the same 30 week format.

To combat summer learning loss, each school has a 4 or 6 week Summer Academy youth program with academic enrichment, recreational and summer school/ tutoring programming. All programming is free.

As part of our Vermont Agency of Education 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grant, our after school programs have an academic component.
