

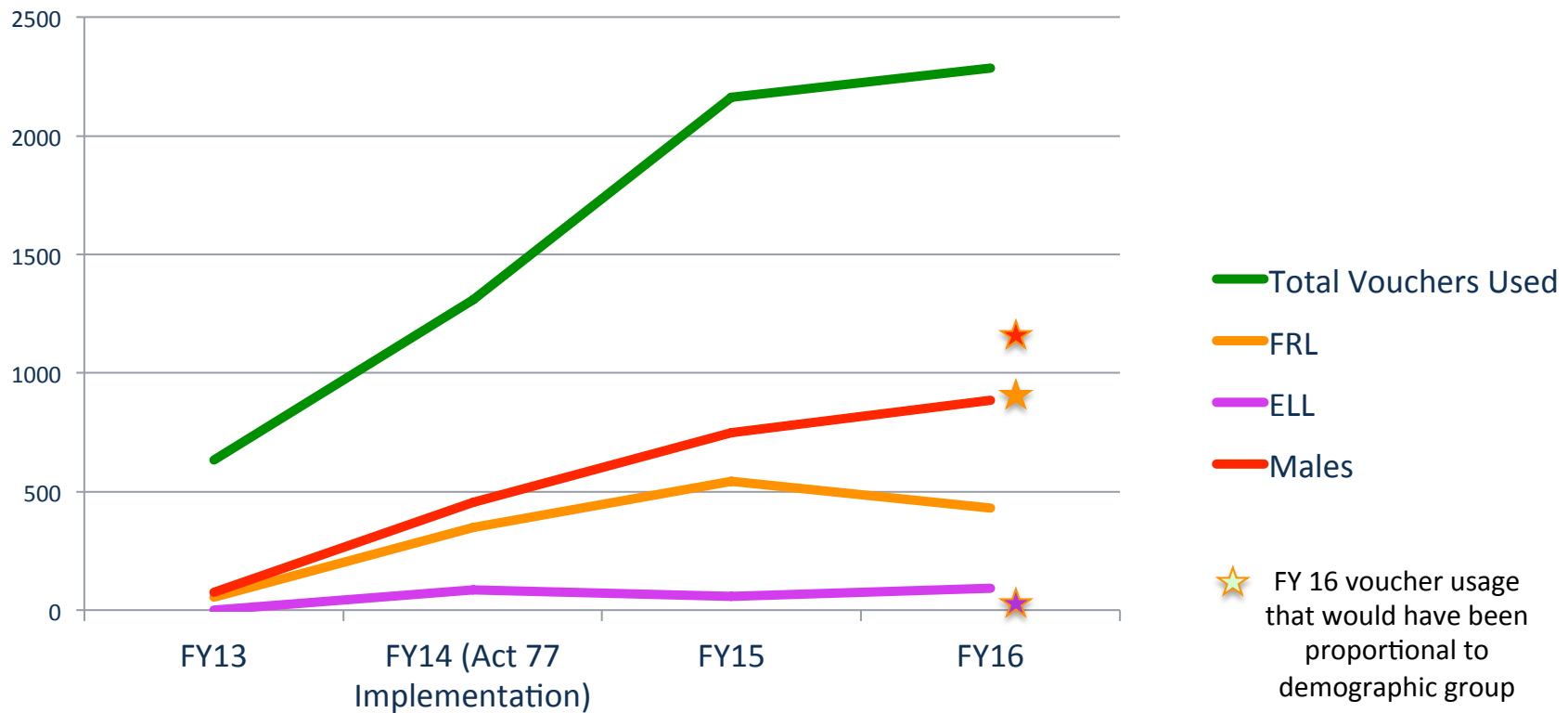

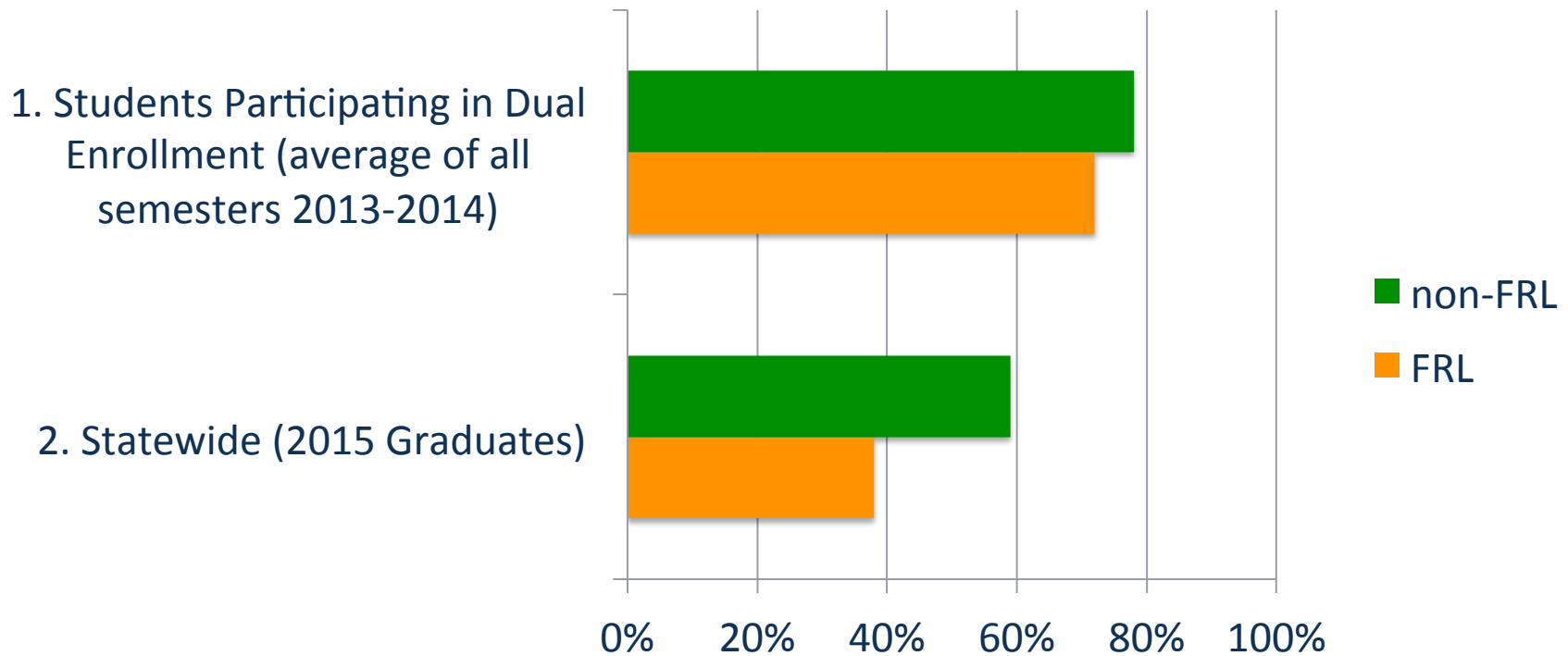

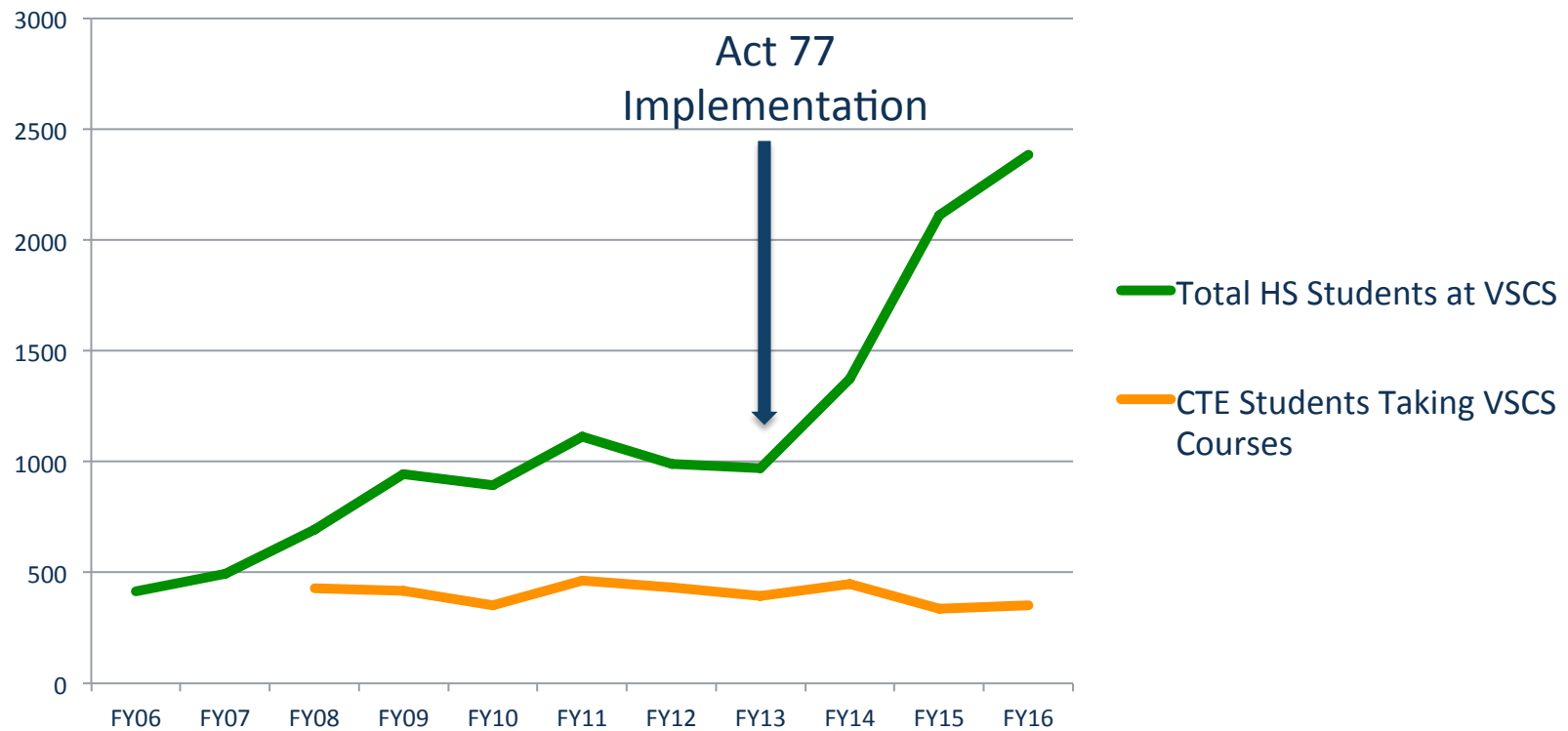
Postsecondary Continuation Rates

High Schoolers in the VSCS



CCV Focus: High Schoolers Served

Intro to College Studies:

60% 1st generation, 70% continue to college

Dual Enrollment:

30% were FRL, 39% were 1st generation in FY16

Early College students:

56% 1st generation, up from 47% in 2015

Comparison points for overall VT population:

19% of all FY16 dual enrollment students were FRL.

~40% of all Vermont high school students are FRL.

38% of all FRL high school graduates continue to college.

Collaborative PD with School Counselors

Mitigation of Costs

- *VSAC stipend for texts, lab fees*
- *VSAC/GEAR-UP tuition for developmental skills courses*
- *CCV Middle School Access Days and Introduction to College Studies supported by VSAC/GU*
- *CCV and Vermont Tech extend reduced rate to students taking courses in high schools and tech centers once they have used their two vouchers.*
