

Occurrences of Base Education Amount (BEA) in Title 16

[16 V.S.A. § 827\(e\)\(2\)](#). Designation of a public high school or an approved independent high school as the public high school of a school district

Limits tuition payment to the BEA by Wells School District to a nondesignated school.

[16 V.S.A. § 1561](#). Tuition reduction

Sub(a) 87% of BEA paid from sending district funds by state to tech center on behalf of the district.

Sub(c) 35% of BEA per Tech student FTE (6 semester average)

[16 V.S.A. § 4001](#). Definitions (13)

[16 V.S.A. § 4011\(b\)](#). Education payments. Sets the BEA at \$6800 in 2005. Grows by NEEP Cumulative Price Index each year. BEA is \$9467 in FY 2017

Sub(e) Early College redesignated to flexible pathways as § 946

[16 V.S.A. § 4015\(b\)\(2\)](#). Small school support. 87% of BEA multiplied by the average grade size factor.

[16 V.S.A. § 4028\(a\)](#). Fund payments to school districts. Districts that do not have a budget 30 days before payments go out receive 25% of BEA per equalized pupil.
