

Extraordinary Special Education Reimbursement

Examples

Example 1

- Assume
 - SU has special education expenditures of \$80,000 for one student
 - Threshold amount is \$70,000 (4.62 X \$15,151 (statewide average district education spending per equalized pupil))
 - Base amount of educational support grant is \$1,800
- Reimbursement would be:
 - $90\% \times \$10,000$ (amount that exceeds threshold) = **\$9,000 +**
 - Lesser of:
 - **\$10,000** (amount that exceeds threshold) or
 - $60\% \times \$68,200$ (\$70,000 (threshold amount) - \$1,800 (base amount)) = **\$40,920**
- Therefore, would receive **\$19,000** (\$9,000 + \$10,000). Under draft 6.1, would have received \$49,920 (\$9,000 + \$40,920).

Example 2

- Assume
 - SU has special education expenditures of \$115,000 for one student
 - Threshold amount is \$70,000 (4.62 X \$15,151 (statewide average district education spending per equalized pupil))
 - Base amount of educational support grant is \$1,800
- Reimbursement would be:
 - $90\% \times \$45,000$ (amount that exceeds threshold) = **\$40,500 +**
 - Lesser of:
 - **\$45,000** (amount that exceeds threshold), or
 - $60\% \times \$68,200$ (\$70,000 (threshold amount) - \$1,800 (base amount)) = **\$40,920**
- Therefore, would receive **\$81,420** (\$40,500 + \$40,920). Under draft 6.1, would have received the same.
