Title 7 Draft Recommendations from Vermont Grape and Wine Council

Pg 12 reads as follows: (no changes, just highlighting important info in bold)

Line 8: (33) "Special event permit" means a permit granted by the Department Line 9 of Liquor Control permitting a licensed manufacturer or rectifier to **sell**, **by the** Line 10 **glass or by the unopened bottle**, alcoholic beverages manufactured or rectified Line 11 by the license holder at an event open to the public that has been approved by Line 12 the local control commissioners.

Pg 83 reads as follows:

Line 15 (1) for the purposes of tasting only; Line 16 (2) by the glass; and Line 17 (3) in quantities of no more than two ounces per product and eight Line 18 ounces total of malt beverages or vinous beverages and no more than one Line 19 ounce in total of spirits or fortified wines to each individual.

Pg 83 changes: (slight disconnect between pg 12 and pg 82). To make clear Pg 83 should read:

(1) for the purposes of tasting only; in quantities of no more than two ounces per product and eight ounces total of malt beverages or vinous beverages and no more than one ounce in total of spirits or fortified wines to each individual.

(2) by the glass.

(3) by the unopened bottle.

Pg 25 reads as follows:

Line 20 (b) A keg shall be sold by a second class second-class licensee only under Line 21 the following conditions:

Pg 25 changes:

Line 20 (b) A keg shall be sold by a second class second-class licensee or **manufacturer** only under Line 21 the following conditions:

Note: Should add **manufacturer in line 20**, since the DLC added the following on Pg 7 and a few of us are selling kegs now.

Line 14 (19) "Keg" means a reusable container capable of holding at least five Line 15 gallons of malt beverage or at **least three gallons of vinous beverage**.

Pg 86 reads as follows:

Line 15 (A) The permit authorizes the employees of the second-class licensee Line 16 to dispense to each customer of legal age on the licensee's premises malt or Line 17 vinous beverages by the glass not to exceed two ounces of each beverage with Line 18 a total of eight ounces of malt or vinous beverages.

Pg 86 changes:

Line 15 (A) The permit authorizes the employees of the second-class licensee **or manufacturer** Line 16 to dispense to each customer of legal age on the licensee's premises malt or Line 17 vinous beverages by the glass not to exceed two ounces of each beverage with Line 18 a total of eight ounces of malt or vinous beverages.
