15	provides indemnification for its standing committee members, officers,
16	directors, employees, and agents.
17	(2)(A) The Commission Board shall adopt rules under 3 V.S.A.
18	chapter 25 procedures pursuant to 3 V.S.A. § 835 to govern the establishment
19	and operation of any multijurisdictional lottery game authorized by this
20	section. For each procedure proposed to be adopted or amended pursuant to
