

Community Integrated Healthcare System 3.0: COMMUNITY-INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE

- Health population-centered, population health-focused strategies
- Integrated networks linked to community resources capable of addressing psychosocial/economic needs
- · Population-based reimbursement
- Learning organization: capable of rapid deployment of best practices
- · Community health integrated
- E-health and telehealth capable

Coordinated Seamless Healthcare System 2.0: OUTCOME-ACCOUNTABLE CARE

- Patient/person centered
- Transparent cost and quality performance
- Accountable provider networks designed around the patient
- · Shared financial risk
- Health information technologyintegrated
- Focus on care management and preventive care

Acute Care System 1.0: EPISODIC NON-INTEGRATED CARE

- Episodic healthcare
- · Lack of integrated care networks
- Lack of quality and cost performance transparency
- Poorly coordinated chronic care management






