The law has made it so simple for people to vote even same day why does it have to be difficult to get a ballot for a loved one. I feel so bad when I have these elderly people come in and request two ballots and we have to say we can only give you yours, he or she will have to come get their own or we can mail it. We have a lot of voters come in and vote but we also have lot who pick up their ballot and then mail it in or drop it off after they are sure of who they want to vote for. I know JP'S can take a ballot to an elderly person but some want to be independent and not ask for help.
