12	(a) The Commission shall endeavor through public education to increase
13	awareness of the importance of full civil and human rights for each inhabitant
14	of this State. The Commission shall also examine and evaluate generally the
15	effectiveness of this chapter as well as the existence of practices of
16	discrimination which detract from the enjoyment of full civil and human rights
17	and shall recommend measures designed to protect those rights.
18	(b) The Commission shall have jurisdiction to investigate and enforce
19	complaints of unlawful discrimination in violation of chapter 139 of this title,
20	discrimination in public accommodations and rental and sale of real estate, and

1	bullying as defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11(a)(32). The Commission shall also have
2	jurisdiction when the party complained against is a State agency in matters for
3	which the Attorney General would otherwise have jurisdiction under
4	subsection (c) of this section.
5	(c) All complaints of unlawful discrimination in violation of 21 V.S.A.
6	§§ 495 et seq. and 710, the Fair Employment Practices Act and the provisions
7	for workers' compensation discrimination, respectively, and of 21 V.S.A.
8	§ 471 et seq. shall be referred to the Attorney General's office, for
9	investigation and enforcement.
