15	(c) The State Librarian shall distribute, in accordance with 29 V.S.A.
16	§§ 1152-1163 and 1191-1193a and other official lists maintained by the State
17	Librarian, the Acts and Resolves of the General Assembly, the legislative
18	directory, the Vermont Statutes Annotated, the Vermont key number digest,
19	the journals of the Senate and House of Representatives, the Vermont reports,

1	and other official reports and documents. The State Librarian shall maintain
2	records of all documents which that he or she distributes.

4	§ 1153a. LEGISLATIVE DIRECTORY
5	The secretary of state Secretary of State shall, at each biennial session of the
6	legislature General Assembly, prepare a legislative directory containing
7	appropriate matter that shall be posted on the Secretary of State's website. A
8	sufficient number of copies of the same shall be printed by December 1 of each
9	odd-numbered year and shall be delivered to the state librarian, who shall
10	deliver one copy to each town and county clerk, each elective and appointive
11	state officer, each member of the general assembly, the clerk of each state
12	board, Castleton, Johnson and Lyndon state colleges, the university of
13	Vermont and state agricultural college, Vermont technical college at Randolph,
14	each high school and academy library in the state, to the secretary and assistant
15	secretary of the senate, the clerk and assistant clerks of the house of
16	representatives, 25 copies to the secretary of state and the remaining copies to
17	the department of libraries. The state librarian may sell copies of the
18	legislative directory to the general public and charge a reasonable price.
19	Receipts from such sales shall be deposited in the general fund.
