10	(a) Insurers shall provide coverage for screening by mammography and for
11	medically necessary diagnostic mammography for, ultrasound, and magnetic
12	resonance imaging to detect the presence of occult breast cancer, as provided
13	by this subchapter and other abnormalities of the breast or breast tissue.
14	Benefits provided shall cover the full cost of the mammography service
15	ultrasound, and magnetic resonance imaging services and shall not be subject
16	to any co-payment, deductible, coinsurance, or other cost-sharing requirement
17	or additional charge, except to the extent that such coverage would disqualify a
18	high-deductible health plan from eligibility for a health savings account
19	pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 223.

1	(b) For females 40 years or older, coverage shall be provided for an annual
2	screening. For females less than 40 years of age, coverage for screening shall
3	be provided upon recommendation of a health care provider. [Repealed.]
4	(c) After January 1, 1994, this This section shall apply only to screening
5	procedures conducted by test facilities accredited by the American College of
6	Radiologists.
7	(d) As used in this subchapter:
8	(1) "Insurer" means any insurance company which that provides health
9	insurance as defined in subdivision 3301(a)(2) of this title, nonprofit hospital
10	and medical service corporations, and health maintenance organizations. The
11	term does not apply to coverage for specified disease diseases or other limited
12	benefit coverage.
13	(2) "Mammography" means the x-ray examination of the breast using
14	equipment dedicated specifically for mammography, including the x-ray tube,
15	filter, compression device, screens, films, and cassettes. The term includes
16	breast tomosynthesis.
17	(3) "Screening" includes the mammography test procedure and a
18	qualified physician's interpretation of the results of the procedure, including
19	additional views and interpretation as needed.
