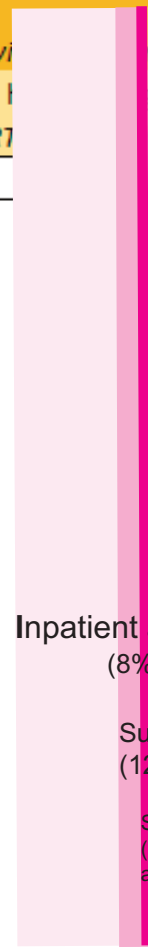


Adult Population of Vermont	~506,000	% of VT population:

DAs serve 16% of all adults getting treatment

**the Designated Agencies provide mental health programming, as well as emergency mental health services, substance use disorder services, and developmental services. Amongst all programs, the Designated Agencies serve approximately 22,000 adults across the system (unduplicated).*

Inpatient admissions: ~4,900/year
 (8% of those receiving treatment)

Subset admitted involuntarily: 597
 (12% of hospitalizations)

Subset committed to hospital: 90
 (15% of involuntary hospitalizations and 1.8% of all hospitalizations)
