13	(b) The Commission shall be composed of $\frac{18}{20}$ members: the
14	Commissioners of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living and of Health
15	or designees, one Senator chosen by the Senate Committee on Committees,
16	one Representative chosen by the Speaker of the House, and 16 members
17	appointed by the Governor. The members appointed by the Governor shall
18	represent the following groups and organizations: physicians, social workers,
19	nursing home managers, including the administrators of the Vermont Veterans'
20	Home, the clergy, adult day center providers, the business community,
21	registered nurses, residential care home operators, family care providers, the

4	members appointed by the Governor shall represent, to the degree possible, the
5	five regions of the State.
6	(c) Eight of the members appointed by the Governor shall serve terms of
7	two years and eight of the members shall serve terms of three years. Members
8	shall serve until their successors are appointed. Members may serve more than
9	one term. Members first appointed to the Commission prior to January 1,
10	2015, may apply to serve no more than one additional term of either two or
11	three years following the expiration of their current term. Members first
12	appointed to the Commission after January 1, 2015, shall serve a maximum of
13	two terms. A member appointed to fill a vacancy occurring other than by
14	expiration of a term shall be appointed only for the unexpired portion of the
15	term, and if the unexpired portion of the term is less than or equal to one year,
16	the member appointed to fill the vacancy occurring other than by expiration of
17	a term may thereafter apply to serve a maximum of two additional terms.
18	(d)(1) For attendance at meetings during adjournment of the General
19	Assembly, legislative members of the Commission shall be entitled to per diem
20	compensation and reimbursement of expenses pursuant to 2 V.S.A. § 406 for
21	not more than four meetings.

2	Vermont and who are not otherwise compensated or reimbursed for their

5	members shall be from the appropriation to the Department of Disabilities,
6	Aging, and Independent Living.
