10	a child, sexual assault, sexual abuse of a vulnerable adult, human trafficking,
11	aggravated human trafficking, murder, arson causing death, and kidnapping
12	may be commenced at any time after the commission of the offense.
13	(b) Prosecutions for manslaughter, sexual assault, lewd and lascivious
14	conduct, sexual exploitation of children under chapter 64 of this title, sexual
15	abuse of a vulnerable adult, grand larceny, robbery, burglary, embezzlement,
16	forgery, bribery offenses, false claims, fraud under 33 V.S.A. § 141(d), and
17	felony tax offenses shall be commenced within six years after the commission
18	of the offense, and not after.
19	(c) Prosecutions for any of the following offenses alleged to have been
20	committed against a child under 18 years of age shall be commenced within 40
21	years after the commission of the offense, and not after:
